## FINDINGS

Two abdominal radiographs dated 5/10/18 are available for interpretation. No prior radiographs area available for comparison.

Abd:

There is decreased abdominal detail. The stomach is gas- and fluid-distended. The small bowel is empty. On the VD projection, there is widening to the pyloroduodenal angle with soft tissue opacity and there is gas within the pyloroduodenal region on the VD projection.

The liver is at the upper limits of normal for size.

## CONCLUSIONS

- 1) Decreased mid-abdominal detail. DDx: ascites and/or peritonitis.
- 2) Gastric distention and lack of contents in the small bowel. DDx: functional ileus secondary to pancreatitis or pyloroduodenal disease vs. mechanical obstruction due to an unseen high duodenal foreign body.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

Abdominal ultrasound with abdominocentesis for fluid analysis and cytology. Complete bloodwork and pancreatic testing. Add in Omeprazole therapy. Fluid therapy

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
